Grad Award Application

Applicants must complete, sign and submit the Nelson & District Credit Union form.

The completed application must be submitted to Seven Summits Centre for Learning by the school deadline.

All applications will be reviewed by the school awards selection committee.

Students should be an active member in good-standing with NDCU.

The successful applicant will be asked to visit the Credit Union to obtain their financial award and have a photo taken with staff or board members after graduation.

Criteria: The recipient of this award will exemplify student spirit.

The students involvement in the community, leadership and academic achievement will be the basis for the award.

Preference will be given to a member in good-standing of Nelson & District Credit Union.

Successful applicant will be required to present NDCU with formal acceptance to their intended institution of study.

Recipients of an NDCU award will have 18 months, from time of graduating, to claim their funds. If funds are not claimed within that time, the financial award will be forfeited.

Applications must be completed in full and returned to the Seven Summits graduation award program coordinator by the stated application deadline.
